

1 This is the location of Well's Park. This area is located west of an existing school property and will eventually contain part of the Flatwoods Trail.

2 This area of undeveloped land is currently owned by the school corporation. When future development is planned, the addition of pedestrian connections from the existing facilities to the neighborhood should be considered for the safety of the students and the health of the community in general.

3 These three areas are all owned by the school corporation, but due to elevation changes in the terrain and the presents of a floodplain not all of the area was developed for school use. The remaining areas are largely undevelopable, but could still be utilized for pedestrian connections to the surrounding residential developments and cross country training paths.

4 This area is the only small park in the heart of the town. It should be promoted as a community gathering space and other public gathering spaces should be added when the opportunity presents itself.






5 The town's utility service is located on this otherwise undeveloped piece of land. The reason for this flat area being undeveloped is due to the fact that it is in a floodplain. This open space could be an ideal space for a northern trailhead that could serve the Ellettsville Heritage Trail.

6 This parcel of land has a lot of potential. Not only as a major connection through town for the Heritage Trail, but as a natural area and a green corridor. This area currently buffers vehicular traffic on State Road 46 from the rear yards of unsightly businesses and steps should be taken to make sure that this natural area is preserved.

7 This small area of land could be turned into a gateway for the town of Ellettsville. It could serve not as a park, but as a focal point to let travelers know they have entered a unique place.

8 This parcel of land currently has multiple sports fields located on it and is owned by the Richland Township Trustees.

9 The fact that the land is almost entirely in a floodplain will need to be taken into consideration, but the Ellettsville Heritage Trail will run through the center of the project should help the projects success. This parcel could also serve as a southern trailhead for the rails to trails project.
